HISTORY & DR. YVONNE FARRELL BIOGRAPHY

The Eight Extraordinary & Complementary Channels as classically practiced, originates from documentation and practice from the Classic Chinese medicine texts from over 2,000 years ago. It is part of the Classical Chinese Medicine, Channel Theory umbrella and Li Gan Jian Ying Daoist practices and principles. Its use and application have evolved over 2,000 years, and its modern application has been disseminated through Daoist Master Jeffrey Yuen. This program dives into the classical and effective application as originally practiced, versus the current teaching of Traditional/Modern Chinese Medicine that was developed in the 1950s.

Dr. Yvonne Farrell, a student of Master Yuen, has been involved in helping others to restore balance in their lives for 30 years. In 1996, she graduated from Emperor's College with a Master's Degree in Chinese Medicine. She has been in private practice since 1997. She was a member of the faculty at Emperor's College for 13 years. In addition to her faculty duties at Emperor's, Yvonne was also a clinical supervisor. In 2007 Yvonne received her Doctoral Degree (DAOM) from Emperor's College. In 2009-2010 Yvonne was the Director of a team that was responsible for getting Yo San University's first DAOM program up and running.

Specializing in the use of the Secondary Vessels in treatment, Yvonne has been teaching channel theory to students for many years. A student of Master Jeffrey Yuen, she has developed proficiency with the Extraordinary Vessel systems and has found they are very effective in the treatment of psycho-emotional and psychospiritual disorders. In addition to teaching in the master's programs of two schools, Dr. Farrell has been teaching CEU courses for several years. Her courses are lively, informative and clinically relevant.

Although she has a general practice, her specialties include the treatment of psycho-emotional disorders or stress induced illness. She is very passionate about the medicine and enjoys sharing this through her teaching.

PROGRAM WITHDRAWAL POLICY:

- For mentorship withdrawals submitted in writing 30 days or more before the start of the course, registrants will receive a full tuition refund less the \$300 non-refundable registration fee and a \$100 admin fee.
- For withdrawals submitted in writing or in person more than 14 days but less than 30 days before the start of the course, registrants will receive a 50% tuition refund, less the \$300 non-refundable registration fee and a \$100 admin fee.
- Without exception, no refunds will be given for withdrawals less than 14 days before the start of the mentorship, and after the mentorship begins.
